Article 1

1.1 Entry to the S.B.T.A. World Championship selection by Individuals, Pair and Team members, is done with the complete understanding and obligation to comply with all rules and procedures as laid down by the S.B.T.A. These rules and regulations are set down below but may be added to and/or amended at the discretion of the Technical Adviser and Executive Council..

Article 2

- 2.1 Entrants must be current Registered members of the S.B.T.A.
- 2.2 Entrants must be legalised British Citizens.
- 2.3 Entrants must hold current British Passport, Independent of Parents.
- 2.4 Entrants must have gained stipulated Grade requirements for the division entered, when applicable. [Not presently applicable 2006]

Junior Category	Grade 1 and 2.
Senior Category	Grade 1,2, and 3.
Team Category	Grade 1 and 2.

Article 3

- 3.1 All travel arrangements will be made by the S.B.T.A. All Athletes must travel with the official party.
- 3.2 Athletes must be prepared to travel in Squad Coach.
- 3.3 All travel and accommodation to be paid by Athlete.
- 3.4 All Athletes must provide Official Uniform at their own expense.
- 3.5 A chaperone will be assigned to all Athletes and shall be responsible for their welfare for the duration of the journey and during the Championships.

- 3.6 During the Championship, all Athletes must adhere to the timetable as laid down by the National Coach of the S.B.T.A.
- 3.7 All Athletes must wear Official Uniform at all times where applicable, or when instructed to do so by a designated official of the S.B.T.A.
- 3.8 All Athletes must attend Official Squad Training prior to the World Championships. Squad training shall be held as and when required. Failure to attend will result in forfeiture of place in squad. (Where a Doctors certificate is provided, re-instatement will be at the discretion of the Executive Council).
- 3.9 Prior to departure for the World Championship, all Athletes are required to attend National Training Camp. Failure to attend will result in forfeiture of place in squad.
- 3.10 All Athletes, Team and Coaches must be prepared to allow designated officials of the S.B.T.A to spectate at training at pre-arranged times. Failure to attend will result in forfeiture of place in squad.
- 3.11.1 Upon selection, all Athletes, automatically come under the jurisdiction of the National Coach and Assistants.
- 3.11.2 Athletes may not change music to Freestyle, Pair or Team once selected. This rule shall only be waived in special circumstances at the discretion of the Executive Council.
- 3.12.1 Athletes who do not conform to the Squad Standards and who conduct themselves in a way which is unacceptable to the S.B.T.A. shall be withdrawn from the Squad and World Championships. These Athletes shall be banned from and S.B.T.A. International Event.
- 3.12.2 Outside interference on behalf of or concerning any Athlete which is unacceptable to the S.B.T.A. shall be withdrawn from the Squad and World Championships.
- 3.13 Any Athlete who is selected for a place in the Scottish Squad and who later withdraws from the Squad, without good and substantial reason, will automatically ban themselves from future selection for the following two years. This rule shall only be waived in special circumstances at the discretion of the Executive Council.
- 3.14 Selection to the Squad is not a guarantee of a place in the Squad. The S.B.T.A reserve the right, at the absolute discretion of the Technical Adviser, to withdraw or disqualify any Athlete who in his/her opinion is either Physically or Psychologically not suited to compete for Scotland at an International Event.
